except that: (a) a defendant served with a request before the defendant's answer is due need not respond until 50 days after service of the request, and (b) a response to a request under Rule 194.2(f) is governed by Rule 195.

RULE 194. REQUESTS FOR DISCLOSURE

You need to go down through the Request and respond to each individual request. In some states, you have to type out the original request before including your response. Check your Rules of Civil Procedure. For example, you can respond to a request this way: "Request No. 1: Please produce a copy of your most recent driver's license.

How to Respond to a Request for Production (with Pictures)

Your response to a request for production consists of two parts. One part is a written response to the requests, in which you state under penalty of perjury that you will produce the requested items; that you will not produce and why; or that you object to a request on legal grounds.

Responding to Requests for Production or Inspection

- Response to Requests for Admission Your response must include the names of the requesting party and responding party, and the set number of the request. You must respond to each request individually. You do not need to repeat the text of the request, but your responses must be in the same order as the requests, and each
