How To Cite A Lab

Start with the department name as the author. An APA citation normally starts with the name of the author of the reference being cited. However, if you're citing to a lab manual, you'll use the name of the university department for which the lab manual was created instead. Follow the department name with a period.

When citing a lab manual in MLA style, start with the author's last name, followed by a comma,

then the first name, followed by a period. Put the location of the manual, a colon and then the publisher, followed by a comma, the year of publication and a period. Also, list the way the manual was read, either online or in print.

If you're writing a lab report for a science class and find that you need to quote or paraphrase information from another source, it's important to cite the source properly. You must cite basic information about the source within the text to let the reader know that you're borrowing from the another author's work.

When you include information from a lab manual in text, put a citation inside parentheses. Insert the name of the issuer of the manual, such as a company, a college department or an instructor's surname. Add a comma and then list the publication year, such as: (Department of Physics, 2012).

If the lab manual was created by a staff member or department of the school and is only available through the class, cite it as an unpublished work. If a department prepared the manual, use it for the name in the citation. Here are the basics: Author's Last Name, First Name (or Department name if no author).

In your writing, you cite or refer to the source of information. A reference gives the readers details about the source so that they have a good understanding of what kind of source it is and could find the source themselves if necessary. The references are typically listed at the end of the lab report.

MLA format follows the author-page method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the page number(s) from which the quotation or paraphrase is taken must appear in the text, and a complete reference should appear on your Works Cited page.

Although this does not address the question of how to cite a lab manual, I did find out how to cite this particular lab manual. The author has informed me that there is in fact an ISBN, 978-0-7380-6200-6 (though I don't think it is listed in all the major databases), and the correct way to cite it would be: O'Connor, Clare M. (2013) *Investigations in Molecular Cell Biology*.

In the body of the lab report itself, a citation normally consists of the last name(s) of the author(s) and the year of publication (Randolph, 1998). This is then expanded upon in your References section. This is a must whenever you cite a source within the body of text so the reader knows
