Refer back to the definition of a prefix. Point out that if we remove the "un" from the word uncle, "cle" cannot stand on its own as a root word. Therefore, this is not a word that includes a true prefix. Introduce students to the most common prefixes and teach their meanings: re, in, im, dis, pre, mis.

In front of the word hook are the letter "un." "Un" is a prefix. A prefix is a word or a group of letters that change the meaning of a word. There are many different prefixes. We are going to talk about 6 of those prefixes today. The prefixes that we are going to talk about are dis, un, re, over, im, and pre.

A prefix is a word part that is placed in front of a base word. Common prefixes include pre, bi, and anti. Take a look at the examples below. A prefix usually changes the meaning of the base word. Think about the word happy. The prefix un placed in front of the word happy makes a new word with a new meaning: unhappy.
